The topics of the conference include, but are not limited to, the following issues:

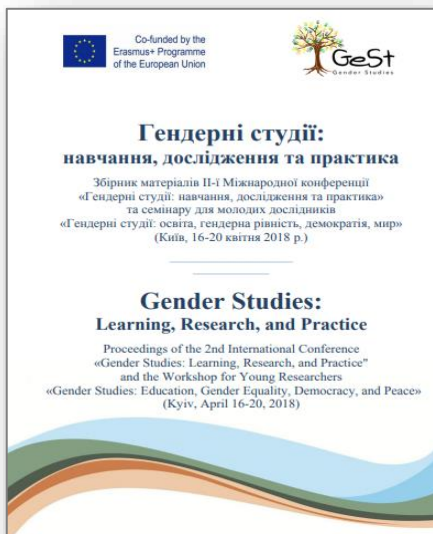

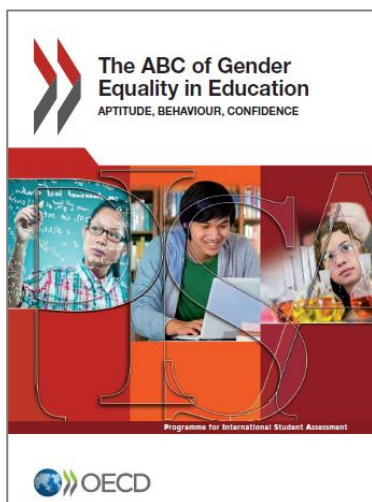
